

Michel Thomas Greek Masterclass Prize; Terms & Conditions:

1. This is a competition to win a place on a one-day language Masterclass given by the authors of the Michel Thomas Method GREEK Course on Friday 28th October 2016 ahead of the Polyglot Conference in Thessaloniki. There will be three winners who will each win a place at the Masterclass (including breakfast and lunch). The Masterclass will last from 10am to 4pm. In addition, each winner will receive 50 Euros towards hotel accommodation in Thessaloniki. The prize does not include travel to/from the hotel, venue or conference or any other expenses. Visas and travel insurance are the responsibility of the winners. In addition each winner will receive a copy of the Michel Thomas Method Greek Total Course and Perfect Course. To enter, please post a reply on <http://fal.cn/ENn4> under the relevant competition post, saying why you would like to learn Greek using the Michel Thomas Method. The three most compelling submissions (in the opinion of the judge) will be picked as the winners.
2. The three winners will be selected from the entries received, in accordance with these terms and conditions, by Richard Simcott, Director of the Polyglot Conference, whose decision will be final.
 - a. By submitting your entry on Facebook, you agree and warrant that (i) your entry is your own original work; (ii) nothing in your entry is defamatory, private or an infringement of copyright or other intellectual property right or in any way a breach of another's right; (iii) any music used in your entry is original to you or you have written permission from the owner. We reserve the right to ask for the permission before any prize is distributed. Any entry in breach of this clause will be disqualified from participating in the competition and from winning any prize.
 - b. By entering the competition, you hereby grant to the Company an irrevocable, perpetual, royalty free, worldwide and for all languages, licence to copy, adapt, edit, distribute, publish, sublicense, and in any and all other ways use your entry for any purpose, in any manner and in all media now known or hereinafter devised. Furthermore, you waive all moral rights whatsoever in your entry. For the avoidance of doubt, the Company is under no obligation to make any use of your entry and the Company shall make no payment to you for any use of your entry.
 - c. We reserve the right to use all the submissions received on our website, our Facebook pages and on our other social networking sites. We will try to include the name of the entrant but this may not always be possible.
 - d. Entries will not be returned.
3. The winners may see their names posted on the Hodder & Stoughton (hereinafter the 'Company') website and on other websites and social media accounts.
4. The Masterclass will be filmed and edited into clips that will be shown at the Polyglot Conference in a presentation on Sunday 30th October, and also edited into a short film to promote the Michel Thomas Method Greek Course via websites such as YouTube. By entering the competition, the winners agree to be part of the filming and for the film to be broadcast at the conference and on the Internet. In addition, winners will be required to sign release forms to agree the same.
5. There is no purchase necessary to enter.
6. The competition opens at 12:01 am BST on 24th August 2016 and closes at 11:59 pm BST on 21st September 2016. Any entries received outside these specified times and dates will not be eligible for entry into the competition.

The competition is open to all delegates attending the Polyglot Conference in Thessaloniki on 29/30 October 2016 except employees of the Company or of companies within the same group of companies, their families, or anyone professionally connected to the competition either themselves or through their families. If any of the winners are under 18 years of age, they will be asked to have their guardian complete waivers, consent forms and/or other documentation as prerequisite for being awarded the prize.
8. Only one entry per person allowed. Second or subsequent entries will be disqualified. Entries will not be accepted via agents, third parties or in bulk.
9. The Company is not responsible for contacting or forwarding prizes to entrants who provide unclear or incomplete information or for entries lost, misdirected, delayed or destroyed.
10. The Company reserves the right to alter the prizes, these terms and conditions, or cancel the competition without notice. No cash or other alternatives to the prizes will be provided.

If a prize is not claimed within 7 days or if a winner is unable to attend the masterclass, then a replacement winner will be chosen from the entries received in accordance with these terms and conditions.
